DURANT FARMER'S MARKET RULES AND REGULATIONS 2023

Hours of Operation: The outdoor Market will be held on Wednesday evenings from 5 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. and are subject to change beginning May 10th through September 13th. The Market will be located 606 5th Avenue, East side of the Community Center parking area.

The Durant Farmer's Market has a handmade, homegrown, or handcrafted policy. All produce or made items sold must be crafted within 100 miles of the Farmer's Market.

The following items are approved for sale at the Market and do not require a license:

Fresh fruits and vegetables (if processed date of processing or canned)

Cottage Food: breads, cakes doughnuts, pastries, buns, rolls, cookies, biscuits and pies (foods must be completely wrapped, covered, bagged, or boxed and labeled with common name of food and preparer name address and phone number, foods containing allergens must be declared).

The following statement: "This product was produced at a residential property that is exempt from state licensing and inspection."

Dried/dehydrated fruits and vegetables plus dry ingredients in a container if shelf-stable and non-hazardous. Meats and poultry (vendor is responsible for monitoring and maintaining proper temperatures according to health codes)

Arts & Handicrafts (please note, all handicrafts must be locally crafted)

The following products may not be sold at the farmers market without appropriate licensing from local, state or federal authorities:

1. Potentially hazardous food products
2. With the sole exception of jams and jellies, no "homestyle" canned goods can be sold at farmers markets since food in a hermetically sealed container shall be obtained from a licensed food processing plant ([Title 21 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 150](#)) (Food and Drug Administration)
3. Wild morel mushrooms
4. Alcoholic beverages

The Iowa Dept. of Inspections and Appeals controls and regulates items that may be offered for sale at farmer's markets. Vendors will be required to follow the regulations that apply to their particular vending items. Information may be obtained at: <https://dia.iowa.gov/food/farmers-markets>

The Market requests no selling of items containing violent, defamatory, profane, obscene, or sexually explicit language or pictures. Vendors are required to have their own personal liability and product liability insurance. Homeowner's policies may already cover your business, or can be easily modified to cover your business.

Copies of certificates of insurance, and all licenses and permits required for the sale of the vendor's products offered for sale at the farmer's market must be provided to the City of Durant.

Vendors will furnish their own equipment. Each vendor will be responsible for the complete cleanup of litter in and around their spaces.

The Community Center Board sponsors the Market but is not held liable for accidents that may occur.
